Since 2014 we have run a Funder Learning Programme, funded by The Robertson Trust, comprising seminars, learning events, workshops, and masterclasses. You may remember our FunderFest 2016 - a particular highlight! Many resources have been developed over the four years and much learning has taken place.

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## Evaluation Support Accounts



Our Evaluation Support Accounts (ESA) offer workshops and tailored support to third sector organisations which are paid for by their funder. Currently we have accounts with:

- R.S. Macdonald Charitable Trust
- The Robertson Trust
- Church of Scotland's Go for It

Each account operates slightly differently depending on the funder's preferences for referral procedures. We recently met with funders to share learning about ESAs enabling funders to learn from each other.

Funders told us that mostly our support is helping organisations report better or make better funding applications.

Working with several funders means that we've been able to join up funders so that more than one funder is contributing to a single organisation's support - sending a strong message of harmonised funders.

There have been times when we have been asked to work with an organisation which has failed to secure funding from the funder. This shows that funders are interested in helping third sector organisations to be in the best position possible when applying for funding.
