

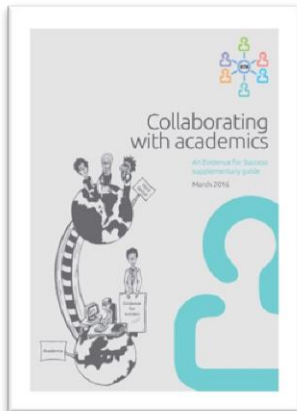


## Launch event:
